

ORDINANCE #1, 2014

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE COMMON COUNCIL FOR THE CITY OF ATTICA
AMENDING THE MUNICIPAL CODE, CHAPTER 9, ARTICLE 2,
SECTIONS 9-22 THROUGH SECTION 9-25,
ENTITLED SEWAGE WORKS RATES AND CHARGES;
ALSO, AMENDING SECTION 9-62
ENTITLED SEWER TAP CHARGE;
ALSO, AMENDING SECTION 9-63,
ENTITLED RESIDENTIAL AND COMMERCIAL WATER TAP
SERVICE CHARGES;
AND ESTABLISHING SECTION 9-26,
ENTITLED STORM WATER CHARGES**

WHEREAS, the Common Council for the City of Attica finds it necessary to amend the rates, charges and fees for the use of the City's sewage works, sewer and water tap fees, and to establish a storm water fee, all to maintain the City's sewage and water systems,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL FOR THE CITY OF ATTICA, INDIANA as follows:

Section 1, Chapter 9, Article 2, Section 9-22 through Section 9-25, which Sections establish sewage use rates for Residential, Commercial, Industrial, and Public Authorities, are hereby amended as set forth in the attached Schedule of Rates and Charges, which attached Schedule is made a part of this Ordinance.

Section 2, Chapter 9, Article 4, Section 9-62, entitled Sewer Tap Charge, is hereby amended to read as follows:

There is established a sewer tap charge in the sum of four hundred dollars (\$400.00) for each sewer tap, plus the cost of the materials used and necessary for the purpose of restoring the area through which the sewer line was run to its original status.

Section 3, Chapter 9, Article 4, Section 9-63, entitled Residential and Commercial Water Tap Service Charges, is hereby amended to read as follows:

- a. There is established a service charge in the sum of five hundred dollars (\$500.00) for the installation of each $\frac{3}{4}$ -inch water line for residential or commercial users.
- b. Any residential or commercial user requiring a service greater than the basic $\frac{3}{4}$ -inch line for water shall be billed for the minimum sum of five hundred dollars (\$500.00) plus the additional cost of the materials required to be used.

Section 4, Chapter 9, Article 2, Section 26 is hereby adopted and shall provide:

There is hereby established a storm water charge in the sum of three dollars (\$3.00) per month for each Residential, Commercial, Industrial, and Public Authority User of the City's sewage system. The charge shall be based upon the use of a water meter.

Section 4, All prior Ordinances or parts thereof inconsistent with the above provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed.
