


CITY OF ATTICA, INDIANA
RESOLUTION # 3, 2019

1. WHEREAS, The City of Attica has participated jointly in the planning process with the other local units of government within Fountain County, Indiana to prepare a Fountain County, Indiana Multi-Hazard Mitigation Plan; and,
2. WHEREAS, The City of Attica recognizes the threat that natural hazards pose to people and property; and,
3. WHEREAS, undertaking hazard mitigation actions before disasters occur will reduce the potential for harm to people and property and save taxpayer dollars; and,
4. WHEREAS, an adopted multi-hazard mitigation plan is required as a condition of future grant funding for mitigation projects; and,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the City of Attica hereby adopts the Fountain County Multi-Hazard Mitigation Plan as an official plan for the City of Attica, Indiana; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Fountain County Emergency Management Agency will submit on behalf of all Fountain County participating municipalities the adopted Fountain County Multi-Hazard Mitigation Plan to the Indiana Department of Homeland Security and the Federal Emergency Management Agency for final review and approval.




