

**COUNCIL PROCEEDINGS  
CITY OF ATTICA**

**SPECIAL MEETING ON 6-20-2022**

The Common Council for the City of Attica met for a special meeting on June 20, 2022, at 6:00 P.M. for the purpose of discussing a revision of the City's nuisance ordinances.

Those present at the meeting were: Council Members Mr. Larry Grant, Mr. Scott Voorhees, Mrs. Patricia Hargan, Mrs. ~~Valerie Maus~~ and Mrs. Kaylie Carnahan. Also, present were Attorney Jud Barce, Mayor Duane Roderick, and Chief of Police Garrett Miller.

The purpose of the special meeting was to review a revision of the nuisance provisions of the City of Attica Code. The revision contained existing Code nuisance provisions and proposed changes. Jud Barce explained that the purposes of the revision were to get all nuisance provisions within the same chapter, provide the offender with notice and an opportunity to correct the nuisance at their expense in a short period of time, assess penalties when the correction is not done in a timely manner, utilize forms for easier implementation and authorize City employees or contractors the right to enter private property and correct the violations.


Mr. Barce explained a proposed penalty of \$250 for the first 30 days of violation after the Notice of Violation voluntary compliance period passed, would enable the Clerk-Treasurer to receive payments for violations that were not timely corrected, without the need to file a small claim or ordinance violation.

The Council members, the Mayor, the Chief and Mr. Barce discussed changes to be made to the Definition section, and input was sought concerning whether to continue to use the existing nuisance provisions for certain violations or use revised suggested language.


Following a review of the entire revised nuisance provisions, Mr. Barce agreed to make requested changes and submit revised nuisance provisions.

Mayor Roderick stated he had no further business and requested a motion to adjourn. **Grant made the motion to adjourn, Carnahan seconded, all were in favor, motion passed, meeting adjourned.**
