#### Miscellaneous Business:

 Dustin Whalen from HWC addressed the BOW requesting a change order for the Perry Street Demolition project. Change order number 1 is an increase in the amount of \$146,850, the description states an asbestos survey of the NAPA building and additional asbestos sampling of the Attica Hotel, as well as an onsite certified asbestos inspector was needed for the project.

Smart made a motion to approve change order #1 in the amount of \$146,850, Gayler seconded the motion passed.

Dustin Whalen from HWC presented change order #2, in the amount of \$87,937.03 the description states the removal of 4 unforeseen underground storage tanks, underground tank pumping, and site testing related to a potentially leaking underground storage tank.
