The Board of Works and Safety for the City of Attica met, pursuant to Public Notice, on Tuesday, October 15, 2024, at 5:00 P.M. in the City Council Room.

- Smart asked what the city needs to do about property at 1110 N. Perry St. because it needs to be condemned. Attorney Redlin said she would look into acting against this property.

**Payroll Vouchers:**

**Miscellaneous Business:**

- Bids for Trash Service effective 1-1-2025 were opened by Attorney Redlin.
  - ❖ Trash Kans LLC **bid 1 \$263,130** per year for 5 years, **bid 2 \$247,695** (this includes a 4x per year clean up vs. 1x per year and all items brought to the sewage plant.) This would be \$16.85 per month per account.
  - ❖ Republic bid \$286,650 + a 5% increase each year for 5 years. This is \$19.50 per account for the first year and a 5% increase each year for 5 years.
  - ❖ Bowles bid \$235,200 per year for 5 years. This would be \$16.00 per month per account.
- **Smart made a motion to table the contract award to the 11-5-2024 BOW meeting to give the city attorney time to review the bids to make sure they are complete and compliant, Grant seconded, motion passed.**

**Claims:**


The claims were presented by Clerk Treasurer, Joanne Broadwater.
