

**COUNCIL PROCEEDINGS
CITY OF ATTICA**

4-14-2025

The Common Council for the City of Attica met on April 14, 2025, at 6:00 P.M.

Those present at the meeting were: Council Members, Mrs. Kaylie Carnahan, Mr. Nathan Maus, Mr. Jim Poynter, Mr. John Smith and Mr. Duane Roderick. Also, present were Mayor Larry Grant, Clerk Treasurer, Joanne Broadwater, and Attorney Ingrid Barce.

The junior Council member present was Grace Hiller and Morgyn Wood.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES OF PREVIOUS MEETINGS:

- Carnahan made a motion to approve the minutes from March 10, 2025, council meeting, Smith seconded, all were in favor and the motion passed.

CITIZENS PETITIONS:

- Tim Kimple thanked the police and fire departments.

COMMITTEE REPORTS:

- Austin Johnson from Bakertilly Municipal Advisors presented the 2024 annual TIF management report to the city council as required by law.

JUNIOR COUNCIL REPORTS:

- The high school pool repair is almost complete.
- Hiller gave an update on the school sports complexes.
- John Smith provided information about school sports.

DEPARTMENT HEADS:

Eric Swank Director of Public Works:

- Was not present.

Police Chief Garret Miller:

- Reported that the city is cleaning up the property at 602 N. 2nd St.
- An ordinance enforcement event started the past weekend.
- Trash cans won't be tagged until Wednesday after Monday pick up if they are still sitting out by the street.
- Officer Smyth has started, the APD currently has 8 officers.

- Officer Albin graduates from ILEA on April 25th, 2025.

Fire Chief Mike Little:

- Was not present,

Joanne Broadwater, Clerk-Treasurer:

- SB1 passed, the local impact is not known at this time.

UNFINISHED BUSINESS:

- Rental house inspections. No applicants for the position.
- No annexation update.
- Ambulance relocation – there is an executive school board meeting scheduled for 4-28-25 to discuss the elementary school property.
- The city grant application is moving forward for a new ambulance building.
- The council redistricting map was distributed. Ordinance 2025-0414A dividing the city into 4 council groups was presented.

Carnahan made a motion to approve 2025-0414A as presented, Maus seconded, Carnahan, Maus and Roderick voted yes, motion passed.

Poynter and Smith abstained from the vote.

- Ordinance NO 2025-0414B was presented, uniform section of penalties for the city. The council discussed the ordinance.

Smith made a motion to approve Ordinance NO 2025-0414B as written, Maus seconded, all were in favor, the motion passed unanimously.

- Ordinance NO 2025-0414C, approving the Attica Fire Protection Territory lease with the Redevelopment Commission.

Roderick made a motion to approve Ordinance NO 2025-0414C as written, Maus seconded the motion, the motion passed unanimously.

- Ordinance NO 2025-0414D, approving the establishment of the Economic Development Commission.

Maus made a motion to approve 2025-0414D, approving the establishment of the Economic Development Commission as written, Poynter seconded, Roderick Poynter, and Maus voted in favor, Smith abstained from the vote, the motion passed.

- Mayor Grant announced the city clean up dates.

- Fire station renovations are slated to begin May 1st and should be completed by the end of the year.
- A citizen requested a reduction in speed limit on S. Brady St. The council discussed the request with the police chief, but no action was taken.
- Mainstreet was given permission to close Perry St. for the Dancing in the Streets festival, there will be fireworks the same evening.
- The location of Mainstreet's farmers market was discussed.

NEW BUSINESS:

- The city has applied for a \$3000 grant from Duke Energy to purchase two new solar speed signs.

- NONE


ADJORNMENT:
