

**MINUTES OF THE REGULAR MEETING OF THE BOARD OF
WORKS AND SAFETY FOR THE CITY OF ATTICA
March 17, 2026**

The Board of Works and Safety for the City of Attica met, pursuant to Public Notice, on Tuesday, March 17, 2026, at 5:00 P.M. in the City Council Room.

Present were Board Members, Chris Gayler, Andy Smart, Mayor, Larry Grant, and Clerk Treasurer, Joanne Broadwater.

Minutes from the previous meeting:

Gayler made a motion to approve the minutes from March 3, 2026, meeting, Smart seconded, all were in favor, and the motion passed.

Citizens petitions:

- A citizen requested a repayment agreement on her water bill due to a burst water pipe; her bill was over \$900. Eric Swank, the Director of Public Works, was asked for confirmation of the leak, Swank stated that he verified the leak and that the water did not go into the city sewer system, so they should receive a sewer credit.

Smart made a motion to approve a sewer credit for the bill, and to allow an additional \$50.00 per month to be paid until the balance is paid in full, Grant seconded the motion, all were in favor the motion passed.

Director of Public Works / Building Commissioner, Eric Swank:

Smart stated he had a citizen report that nails were dropped in the street on North Perry St. as junk was being hauled out of a property, he wanted to make Eric aware of it.

- **Mayor Grant presented the We Care contract renewal.**


Smart made a motion to approve the We Care contract, Grant seconded the motion, and the motion passed.
