

**MINUTES OF THE REGULAR MEETING OF THE BOARD OF
WORKS AND SAFETY FOR THE CITY OF ATTICA
April 7, 2026**

The Board of Works and Safety for the City of Attica met, pursuant to Public Notice, on Tuesday, April 7, 2026, at 5:00 P.M. in the City Council Room.

Present were Board Members, Chris Gayler, Andy Smart, Mayor, Larry Grant, also present was Clerk Treasurer, Joanne Broadwater and Attorney Mallory Redlin.

Minutes from the previous meeting:

Citizens petitions:

- A utility customer asked for an extension until April 20th to pay her disconnect bill that was due on the 10th.

The claims were presented by Clerk Treasurer, Joanne Broadwater.

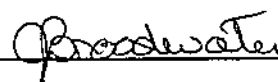
- **Gayler made a motion to approve claims, Smart seconded, the motion passed.**
